

EXAMPLE

A) Smoke-Free Public Events

1) Purpose.

The purpose of this section is to protect the public's health, safety, and welfare by addressing and prohibiting smoking/vaping and second-hand smoke/vape during public events.

2) Definitions.

(a) "Tobacco and/or cannabis/marijuana products, substitutes and/or alternatives" shall mean cigarettes, electronic cigarettes, vapor cigarettes, cigars, cheroots, stogies, blunts, splifs, dabs, rollies, refuse scraps, clippings, cuttings and sweepings of tobacco and/or cannabis/marijuana, and other kinds and forms of tobacco and/or cannabis/marijuana prepared in a manner suitable for smoking in a pipe and/or vape device or otherwise for smoking.

(b) "Smoking" shall mean possession of lighted tobacco and/or cannabis/marijuana products or use of tobacco substitutes and/or alternatives including vaping.

(c) "Public Event" shall mean any event open for the general public. Exhibitions, sports exhibitions, festivals, entertainment, cause-related, fundraising, leisure, and any event that is a one-time or periodic, free or ticketed, cultural, charitable or cause-related, and conducted for the purpose of attracting revenue, support, awareness, and/or for entertainment purposes, and created by and/or for the general public.

3) Exceptions.

The prohibition of smoking/vaping during a public event shall not apply to:

(a) Any person(s) and/or company/organization who is granted (for good reason) special permission to smoke/vape, by vote of the Lyndon Outing Club Board members and is therefore documented in writing and available during the event and to public record, be able to hold an event within the park limits to include smoking/vaping as long as the event is conspicuously marked so.

NOTE: Lyndon Outing Club may assess a fee upon allowing a vender to hold an event without smoking restrictions.

4) Enforcement.

Any law enforcement officer, Board member and/or park goer may enforce the provisions of this policy.
